



Discipline

Proverbs 13:24 The one who will not use the rod hates his son, but the one who loves him disciplines him diligently.

- It is the goal of ACA to build relationships with students and to train students through consistent accountability. ACA empowers the family to discipline and instruct each child. Students will be corrected privately and praised publicly. Staff and parents are expected to work with one another to help guide children; if proper steps are not made a child will not travel into the community with the academy. Restoration of behavior is the goal for all students. Individual consequences/behavior plans will be given to meet individual children's needs.

Behavior

- ACA hold high standards for the conduct of its students. Students are expected to be respectful to teachers and administration, considerate of their classmates, and complete their work. Student who do not follow behavior guidelines will have a conference during recess with their teacher or another administrator. In some circumstances students will receive one-on-one counseling on Fridays in lieu of traveling with the academy.

Three Strike Policy

- If a student receives three behavior conferences, there will be a scheduled meeting to with family, staff, and association members to determine next steps.
