- Provide time for at least one parent-teacher conference per child per year.
- Maintain the quality of the program by providing professional development for teachers.
- Resolve student conflicts and difficulties alongside families
- Provide opportunities for parent education and involvement (volunteer possibilities)
- Provide a faith-based environment that will include prayer, scripture memorization, and incorporate biblical principles in our daily academy life.

### **The Family commits to:**

- Understand that this is an academy of choice and agree to support the school and teachers in their endeavor to educate.
- Assume primary responsibility for the values, attitudes, and behavior of their children, and support the school's discipline and integrity policies.
- Support the curriculum by actively striving to assist students in the home.

- Encourage and model respectful attitudes and speech when speaking with educators and peers.
